POVERTY IN PRESTON

Many neighbourhoods in Preston have long suffered high levels of deprivation. With the recession, growing unemployment and tightening of benefit entitlements, need increases. Many households on tight budgets have to choose between food and other necessities like heating or clothing. Already churches like The Salvation Army, Freedom Centre, Longton, Community Church, Fulwood, Free Methodist Church and St Mary's, Leyland are regularly giving out food parcels to needy households. They report ever increasing need. At The Salvation Army alone up to 50 households are helped each month. Referrals include families with young children, young people, homeless and near homeless adults.

The idea is to bring all sectors of the community together to jointly support families and individuals in crisis or at risk of becoming vulnerable through food poverty.
